Where can you help?

ARTIST AMBASSADOR

Responsible for booth sitting for artists while they take a break, distributing informational materials, and serving refreshments throughout the day.

ARTIST SET UP

Assist with directing artists to their booth location and, if necessary, help set up their exhibit canopy on Friday from 11:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. or Saturday from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.

GROUNDS CREW

Responsible for maintaining a neat and orderly art fair by picking up trash and recyclables and arranging tables and chairs.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE

With three distinct areas of food and refreshment to satisfy the hungry art buyer volunteers are needed to prepare food, serve, and collect money. Volunteers must be at least 21 years of age to work in areas that serve alcohol. All food and beverage areas are operated by the Greenwich Village Art Fair Committee and generate revenue for the educational programs and operations of Rockford Art Museum.
